An invitation is extended to all FIRE APPARATUS BUFFS in the Central Pennsylvania area to attend a meeting on June 11, at 7:30 p.m. at 4904 Jonestown Road, for the purpose of establishing a chapter of the "Society for the Preservation and Appreciation of Antique Motor Fire Apparatus in America", (SPAAMFAA for short).

Founded in 1958, SPAAMFAA is a non-profit, educational and historical society comprised of over 1,300 members who are dedicated to preserving, restoring and operating the apparatus that are so much a part of our heritage.

There are presently thirteen regional chapters who together with the national society sponsor nearly two dozen musters each year. Publications include an illustrated quarterly magazine and an annual roster of members and their apparatus.

It is emphasized that it is not necessary to own an antique fire apparatus to belong to the society, only a desire to preserve and foster the rich heritage of this segment of the fire service.
